VOLUNTEER ROLE OVERVIEW

The position of “Mentor” is vital to the success of the TMC Program. A Mentor is responsible for building a relationship and providing support to her teen mom throughout the teen mom’s time in the program.

QUALIFICATIONS

Required:

- ▶ Born-again Christian
- ▶ Concerned with her own spiritual growth
- ▶ Actively involved with a church
- ▶ A wife and mother

Recommended:

Ability to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ in everyday conversations

DUTIES IN RELATIONSHIP TO THE TEEN MOTHERS

- ▶ Attend weekly LifeSkills Workshops
- ▶ Assist the teen mom with identifying and completing her goals, including meeting with the teen mom and Financial Counselor
- ▶ Commit to connecting with teen mom throughout the week (i.e., one-on-one meetings, text, phone calls)
- ▶ Serve as the teen mom’s go-to person within the TMC Program

DUTIES IN RELATIONSHIP TO OUR PROGRAM

- ▶ Attend Volunteer and Mentor Training
- ▶ Attend monthly Mentor Meetings
- ▶ Share milestones and areas of concern with the Program Director
- ▶ Participate in the volunteer and evaluation programs
